Shareholders Dispute

- ***JS Success Ltd v Cheung Theobald Aylwin & Ors* [2025] HKCFI 3837** (as sole advocate) – represented the majority shareholders of the company in successfully defending an unfair prejudice petition in a 6-day trial arising from a joint venture of restaurant business.
